

Claims Conference Homecare Program

The Home Care program was created in order to assist clients that are Holocaust survivors in maintaining independence in their own homes. One of the main focuses of the program is to reduce isolation. The program is funded by Conference on Jewish Material Claims against Germany. The program works closely with home care companies to provide for clients' needs and agency's own support staff in order to achieve the goals.

Services that are provided include:

- Initial Assessment
- Home Care services that include:
 - Housekeeping: cleaning and cooking
 - Accompaniment to doctor's appointments
 - Assisted shopping
 - Personal Care
 - Assistance in reducing social isolation
- Monitoring client's health and reassessing if needed
- Monitoring of client's satisfaction from the services
- Connection to Government or Community services and Advocacy
- Client-directed long-term intervention
